FAQ's



• How do I schedule my classes?

All students will receive their schedule during the first six days of school. At TSHS, students are registered based on their grade level cohort. Students will meet with their Crew Leader or our Counselor, Travis Weese, to determine their elective classes.

• What bus do I take?

All students take Bus #5 from CHS to TSHS. The bus leaves CHS at 7:50 Am each morning and from TSHS at 2:10 Pm.

• Do I need to register to take the bus?

If you are new to TSHS this school year, including 9th-grade students, please follow this link to register to ride the bus. After filling out the form, please fill it out and email it to Amy Hill, <u>ahill@cheneysd.org</u>, and she will get your student on a route. <u>Bus Registration Form</u>

• What school supplies do I need?

Students will need minimal supplies to begin the school year. Some supplies are in our school supplies closet for students to access as needed. There are other items that teachers may ask for throughout the year as projects are designed.

How much does breakfast and lunch cost?

Breakfast and lunch is free to all TSHS students. Our meals are transported to us from the Cheney High School Kitchen. While meals are free, we ask that you please fill out the Nutrition Services forms that were sent to your home. This information supports the continued option of free meals at our school. Also important, many other sources of funding for our school also depend on the completion of this paperwork. In addition, your child may qualify for reduced ASB fees, club fees, etc. If you need another copy of the form please let us know!

• What if I have allergies or a health concern?



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
