From now until the end of the year, counselors will be hard at work ensuring that these schedule requests are appropriate for your child's current needs and future plans. In addition, they will be working with the graduating class of 2024 to ensure they are as prepared as possible for what lies ahead! This includes having completed the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), applying for scholarships or grants, and putting students in contact with potential colleges, universities, or workforce personnel!

In addition to extracurriculars, co-curriculars, and future planning, the spring semester is an academically busy time! Students in the state of Louisiana participate in a variety of state assessments in the spring semester, including the ACT, Pre-ACT, as well as the Workkeys test (given throughout the year for some groups). It is believed that exposing all students to the ACT and related tests provides them with the needed familiarity in regards to content and format! Students enrolled in English I, English II, Geometry, Algebra I, Biology I, and US History classes will also take the LEAP 2025 assessment in the coming months. This year, the administration of LEAP 2025 assessments will occur May 8-10. In addition to being graduation requirements, these assessments are worth 20% of the student's course grade. It is hard to believe that we have only a few months left in the 2023-24 school year. As a reminder, Spring Break will occur March 29 - April 7 (including weekends). Attention Seniors! If you have not completed the FAFSA you need to do so as soon as possible! Remember that this is now a graduation requirement. If you need guidance on how to get started please reach out to your counselor. If you completed the FAFSA from February 15 until now, please forward your confirmation email to your counselor. Remember, you will NOT be able to purchase prometickets if you have not completed the FAFSA and submitted proof to your counselor.

Attention 12th Grade Students: In order for your scholarship to be included in the graduation program, your scholarship offer letter(s) must be turned in to Mrs. Kellie Tabor in room AG7 as soon as possible. Even if you do not plan to take the scholarship, we would like to make sure your award is noted in the program. The deadline to submit this information is April 26th.

Seniors, remember to check the HHS Counselor webpage for upcoming scholarships. The page is updated on a daily basis so be sure to check often.

Juniors – if you are planning to take a DE class next year in your senior year and you do not get the composite score needed, you can register to take the National test this summer and still qualify. Please see your counselor if you have questions.

Do you speak a world language besides English? Students who demonstrate their knowledge of a world language on the AAPPL Exammay be able to earn the foreign language credits they need to graduate without taking a foreign language class. We offer the test in Arabic, Mandarin Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, and Spanish. Email or see your counselor for more information about the AAPPL Exam.

"What is Wellness?"


The act of achieving "wellness" in life involves physical, mental, and social wellbeing. Wellness is not simply the absence of physical ailments, which is what we often think of



HHS Families, are you aware of the ACT testing dates for this school year? Read below to plan opportunities for your student to test! All Juniors will be testing on March 7, 2023 here at HHS. Any Senior wishing to retest will also have the chance to sign up to test on that day as well. There are also national test dates for which students can register. Please reach out to your counselor for information about ACT scores and TOPS, Dual Enrollment, and scholarship opportunities.

Notice: In 1986 all asbestos materials were identified in all school buildings. A management plan was developed for each school as per the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). The management plan is located in a binder in the main office of each school. The binders are available for review upon request.

Since the plan was developed, most of the asbestos has been removed. In a few buildings, some floor tile still remains that contains asbestos. All of the schools meet the health require/ments that pertain to the regulation.
