Counselors' Corner

Seniors, be sure to check the "Counselor" section under "Academics" on the HHS website as well as the Counselor Google Classroom for important college and scholarship information.

Senior parents, the counselors have begun meeting with all seniors to give them information about completing the FAFSA. The first step is to create an FSA ID for the student and one for the parent that will be completing the FAFSA with the student. The FAFSA application is being revamped so it will not open until some time in December. Be sure to complete the 2024-2025 application since that is when your student will attend college. Please review all of the important information your senior will be sent home with in order to successfully submit the FAFSA since it is a graduation requirement.

9th-11th grade parents please know that planning for the next school year will begin soon and we will start meeting with students to have them start the elective course choices for 2024-25 school year. It is always helpful when you take the time to review the "Course Catalog" with your child and evaluate which electives he/she would like to take. This document can be found online under "Academics". If you would like to schedule a meeting about scheduling for your student, please email your student's counselor to set that up. The list is below along with the email for the counselors.

The counselors now have a Kiosk at lunch every day during both lunches. Remind your students to come and stop by to ask questions or get information.

Please make sure your students have joined the correct Counselor's Google Classroom. The counselors will use their Google Classrooms this year to post important information and reminders to the students. If your student needs a Google Classroom code, please have them stop by the counseling office or email their counselor.

Attention Seniors! The 2022-2023 HHS Community Scholarship Application will be collected as a Google Form. Students can access the link on their Counselor's Google Classroom starting on November 7th. The paper copy is only for you to prepare your answers for the Google Form application. Please take the time to complete the Google Form application thoroughly in order to best qualify for scholarships that will be presented during Junior/Senior awards night. You must submit the Google Form before Monday, December 19th at 2:20pm to be considered for HHS Community Scholarships. **IMPORTANT:** If you would like to be considered for any of the financial need based scholarships then you **MUST** select an income (\$0-200,000+). Failure to select any dollar amount of income will eliminate you from consideration for any need based community scholarships. Also, certain scholarships **REQUIRE** proof of community service. Please make sure you have documentation of ALL proof of your listed community service. **YOU MUST BE READY TO PROVIDE THIS PROOF IMMEDIATELY IF SELECTED.** Please see Mrs. Kellie Tabor in AG7 or email Ms. Paige Walther at pwalther@stcharles.k12.la.us if you have questions.

- Showing gratitude can improve psychological health by decreasing toxic emotions and **increasing happy emotions. The word “gratitude” means the quality of being thankful;**
- readiness to show appreciation for and return kindness. Showing gratitude enhances empathy towards others and decreases the feeling of aggression. Research states that grateful people are more likely to conduct themselves in a more positive manner, even when others are less kind in their approach.

There are times when it is difficult for our students to voice their feelings, so having a conversation and explaining to our students various reasons why they should be thankful promotes positivity amongst our community. Students can be thankful for their family bond, the presence of a caring teachers, or the ability to go to school and engage with friends. Being thankful and showing appreciation speaks to a **person’s character and encourages us to be self-aware** as well as socially aware of how our actions can positively impact others. Simply saying **“good morning” to the bus driver, saying “thank you” to a cafeteria staff worker, or saying “have a great day” to a friend can put a smile on a person’s face and in essence will make you feel good as well.
