## About the class....

AP World History is designed to be the equivalent of a two-semester college or university world history course.

The course covers from the foundations of human society (8,000 BCE) until modern-day. Major themes include:

1. Interaction Between Humans and the Environment
2. Development and Interaction of Cultures
3. State Building, Expansion, and Conflict
4. Creation, Expansion, and Interaction of Economic Systems
5. Development and Transformation of Social Structures

## Homework/Classwork

Students are expected to read college level texts averaging one to two chapters per week. Additionally they will be required to complete reading guides, Cornell notes and document analysis packets on a regular basis.
