Citizen-Led Oversight Committee (CLOC)

- The CLOC is an independent group of volunteers who monitor all referendum building projects, schedules, budgets and expenditures. Quarterly reports from the CLOC are presented to the Beaufort County Board of Education and posted to this website. Minutes/Presentations of CLOC meetings are posted once approved by the committee.
- CLOC members bring a wide variety of professional experiences to their tasks. Members include CPAs, urban planners, civil engineers and project managers.
- The committee serves as an independent watchdog by monitoring projects and spending and then reporting directly to the public and the Board of Education.

Independently monitor **all building projects, schedules, budgets, and expenditures** from the Beaufort County School District's Nov. 2019 Bond Referendum, thereby ensuring proper use of Beaufort County taxpayer funds and superior facilities for Beaufort County students.

- Baseball Parking and North Parking Lots are complete; South Parking lot is scheduled for Paving the week of July 8, 2024
- Baseball & Softball: Fields are 90% complete
- Baseball/Softball Concessions, Football Concessions and Restrooms are scheduled for Substantial Completion the week of July 22, 2024
- Other Item(s) To Note:
 - On April 23, 2024, LS3P issued a Substantial Completion Notice Letter to J.E. Dunn that in their opinion, J.E. Dunn had not reached Substantial Completion for Phase 2 by the contractual date of April 23, 2024; This Notice Letter included formal notice that the Owner intends to pursue liquidated damages at the rate of \$750 per calendar day until Substantial Completion has been achieved
 - South Parking Lot scope has a conflict with Underground Utilities; JED is revising their proposal to address review comments; The work will add an additional 14 calendar days to the Substantial Completion

Financial Update

- Individual budgets have been adjusted and tracked using the Program Contingency Log; Budget increases were supported by the Referendum Contingency and Bond Premiums
- The dollars spent and encumbered did not exceed budgeted project totals
- The dollars spent per project did not exceed the estimated project percent completed
- Turner & Townsend Heery continues to report a "soft landing" with analysis forecasting funds will remain after closeout of the 2019 Bond Referendum Program
