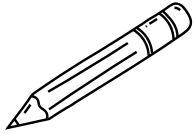


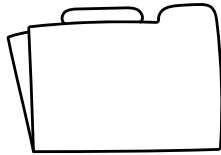

Grading

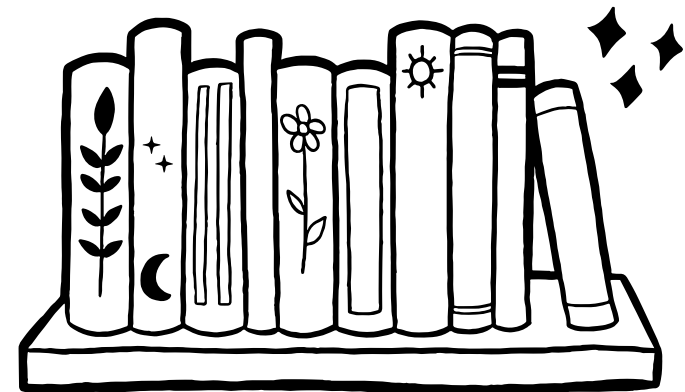

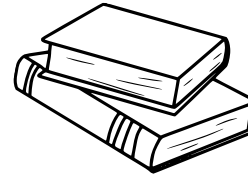

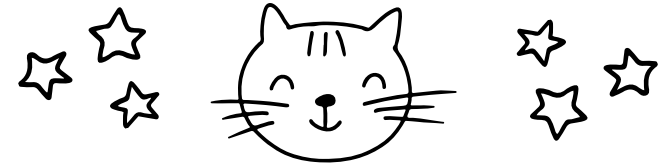
