### Welcome and Introductions:

Anna welcomed the group. Attendance was taken. Anna reviewed the norms.

### Review and Approve Minutes:

Group reviewed the minutes from the October meeting.

### State of the School

Annie Petrie reported that she was able to receive feedback from the staff, students, and teachers about the effectiveness of the current schedule.

### ELAC/DELAC

Action steps are being put into place for areas that have been reviewed as somewhat effective.

We will know whether there will be 3 or 6 years of accreditation hopefully soon.
