1:1 Mobile Device Agreement

Agreement between user and Thornwilde Elementary School (TES)

Students will receive a Chromebook to use at school and at home (when applicable) as a means to promote achievement and provide for flexible learning opportunities. The Chromebook is the property of Boone County Schools. Students are expected to use technology responsibly and they must understand the appropriate and responsible use of the technology and school network resources. TES also expects that students will keep their devices safe, secure, and in good working order.

This agreement must be reviewed and signed by the TES student and their parent/guardian. It includes the below review of expectations on responsibilities, restrictions, ownership, conditions, and liability. This form is completed annually and must be on file for a student to utilize a Chromebook.

Responsibilities and Restrictions

By accepting responsibility for this device, I acknowledge and agree to the following conditions:

- Students are expected to abide by the AUP (found in the Boone County Code of Conduct).
- Student use of TES equipment is filtered on and off school property. No filter is perfect, and TES cannot guarantee students will not intentionally or unintentionally access content that is inappropriate.
- Students are responsible for all content on their Chromebook. Any inappropriate content, in any form (pictures, text, animation, video, sound, etc.) will be grounds for disciplinary action.
- Students will notify their classroom teacher immediately if the mobile device needs repair, is lost or stolen.
- Students must leave all setting functions of the device as set by Boone County Schools.

Some commonsense actions the user must take to protect their device, software, and confidential data that may be on the mobile device include, but are not limited to the following:

- Do not leave your device unattended in a car, an unlocked home, or in a public place.
- Keep information password-protected; log off when you are away from your device.
- Protect from liquids or dampness.
- Protect from extreme temperatures (i.e., do not leave in trunk of car for long periods of time.)
- Transport the mobile device carefully.
- Do not load or add software, apps, or extensions without teacher or administrator permission.

Ownership

I understand that I am responsible for any damage to the mobile device. TES may request the mobile computing device and software be returned at any time. Upon request of TES or termination of the agreement, I must return the mobile device to TES in the same condition it was received, reasonable wear and tear expected. I understand that TES may ask to examine the device at any time.

Conditions and Liability

I agree to accept the mobile device and software "as is." In no event shall TES be liable to me for my use of the mobile device. I understand that in the event of theft, misuse, or carelessness, there is no provision for replacement by TES. I understand that if loss or damage occurs while the mobile device is in my possession, I am responsible for any damage, and in case of theft, for filling and official police report and informing TES immediately.

If a student leaves TES, but does not return the mobile device, a fine for the full replacement cost will be placed on the student record, and standard rules for the restriction of records and transcripts will apply. Law enforcement may be involved for the purpose of recovering TES property.
