

SUBJECT: OPERATION OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES ON DISTRICT PROPERTY

The use of motor-driven vehicles, including cars, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) and other such vehicles is prohibited on any school grounds or areas except for authorized school functions or purposes.

Student Vehicles on School Property

Driving a vehicle to school as a student is a privilege and not a right. Permits will be issued at the beginning of each school year at the discretion of the administration on the basis of need and past behavior.

Administration will disseminate rules and responsibilities to those students who drive a vehicle to school.

The first violation of rules will result in suspension of driving privileges for one week. Further violations will be dealt with by longer periods of suspension or removal of privilege.

If a student has driving permission canceled, the student's parents will be notified. If the student continues to drive on campus in violation of school directives, the Sheriff's Office will be notified of the situation for possible further action as deemed appropriate.

All student vehicles are to be registered with the school principal and parked in authorized areas only.
