SUBJECT: NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Non-resident families who wish to enroll children in the School System shall submit a request in writing to the Superintendent, who shall make a recommendation to the Board of Education. The following general conditions for acceptance will be considered by the Superintendent:

- a) There is sufficient space to accommodate the non-resident student and
- b) No increase in the size of faculty or staff will be necessary

Final decisions regarding the acceptance of non-resident students rest with the Board of Education.

All rules and regulations in effect for District students will be applicable to non-District students.

Parents/guardians must work out transfer conditions with home school district.

Non-resident families must provide their own transportation. Families may coordinate transportation with the BCS transportation department and arrange to be picked up by a Belfast bus at a pick-up point within the District.

On an annual basis, the Superintendent of Schools shall communicate this policy to all non-resident parents of students desiring attendance and request application be made for non-resident attendance.

- a) Non-resident students must be in good academic and behavioral standing to attend Belfast Central School
 - Belfast Central School reserves the right to discontinue attendance of a non-resident student if he/she has repeated academic (i.e. refusing to do school work) and/or behavioral issues while attending Belfast Central as a non-resident student.
- b) Non-resident students must participate in all mandated NYS assessments.
