SUBJECT: SUMMER SCHOOL GRADING

Effective for the summer of 2006 and beyond, Belfast Central School, in cooperation with the Belmont Career and Technical Center, will implement the following grading policy to determine final grades in courses. Per Belfast Central School's policy, a student must earn at least a 55% in a course and have satisfactory attendance to be eligible for summer school. Upon completion of a summer school course, a final course average will be determined using a 60/40 ratio. 60% of the grade will be the final average earned during the school year and 40% will be the final summer school grade. For example: if a student had a 55% in a course before entering summer school and received an 80% in summer school, the final reported average would be a 65%.
