- a. To appoint Jason Hamer to the position of Senior Maintenance Mechanic effective July 1, 2022, with a one year probationary appointment. Mr. Hamer will be eligible for a permanent appointment July 1, 2023.
- b. To appoint Katelyn Davis who holds an Initial NYS Certificate permitting her to teach in grades PK-6, to the position of Elementary Education Teacher in the elementary education tenure area for a probationary period of four years, to commence August 29, 2022 and to end August 29, 2026. Eligibility for tenure at the end of the probationary period is dependent on Mrs. Davis receiving APPR ratings of Effective or Highly Effective in <u>3 of 4</u> preceding years and no ineffective composite or overall ratings in the final year.
- c. - d. Eligibility for tenure at the end of the probationary period is dependent on Mrs. Guilford obtaining NYS certification as a library/media specialist.
