At 6:31 p.m., President Hull called the meeting to order.

Schneider project update

Minutes

Jim Schneider updated the board on the status of current projects. He noted that the older phases are now complete. Mr. Schneider stated that the front parking lot was repaired in house, and that it should be looked at in the next couple of years as something that will need to be done again. He spoke about the Performance project stating the completion date was projected to be January 1, 2017; most of the work is done. He noted that the weatherization of the school and the repair of the walk in cooler/freezer were both jobs well done. He also noted that Siemen's will recommend a temperature setting for the school to aid in energy conservation. Mr. Schneider stated he was told the batting cage will be delivered between March 3 and March 9, 2017, and that installation should begin a day or two after delivery. Mrs. May gave the board date for upcoming bid opening.

Judy May talked about the sports schedule for spring 2016, and the disadvantages small schools have building teams with a small population. She used cheerleading as an example to stress that alternatives can be found to benefit students. We will not have varsity softball due to low sign up numbers.

Mrs. May asked if March's meeting could be held on Monday, March 13, instead of Tuesday, March 14, 2017. Moving the meeting just for the month of March, will assist David Hanks' transition into interim superintendent.
