Ms. Bunt talked about the library's desire to increase the number of computers available for public use. She also explained that a variety of computer programs are available, but that they are costly and have expiration dates.

President Hull called for nominations for the Belfast Town Library Board of Trustees for the expired term of Vickie Chamberlain. Michael Hamer nominated Beth Hazelton. Mark Sullivan seconded the nomination. There were no other nominations, thereby Beth Hazelton's name will appear on the ballot for Library Trustee at the May 16, 2017 budget vote and election.
