

BUDGET SUMMARY

- The proposed 23-24 budget maintains all student programs.
- Additional positions are being recommended to bring BCS back to full staff.

2023-2024 BUDGETED EXPENDITURES



- Total budget is \$11,813,963 (10% increase from last year)
- Majority of the expenses
 - Salaries/benefits (56%)
 - BOCES services (17%)
 - These two expenses make up a combined 73% of the budget.

NOTABLE CHANGES IN BUDGET

- Teachers
 - Hires new elementary teachers
 - Adds a new Speech Teacher
 - Transitions two current Teacher Assistants to Teachers
 - The budget supports two sections at every grade level K-6.
- School Related Personnel
 - Finalized a new SRP contract

NOTABLE CHANGES IN BUDGET

- Health Insurance Premiums
 - 10% premium increases
- Purchase of a brand new 66 passenger bus (\$161k) cost increased 22% from last year
- Addition of new BOCES Services
 - Exceptional Ed. Support
 - Frontline Financial Analytics
 - Technology Support
- Utility increases due to the cost of energy


2023-24 CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT

- Update auditorium doors to include card swipes to address security
- Replace outdated emergency exit lights in the building
