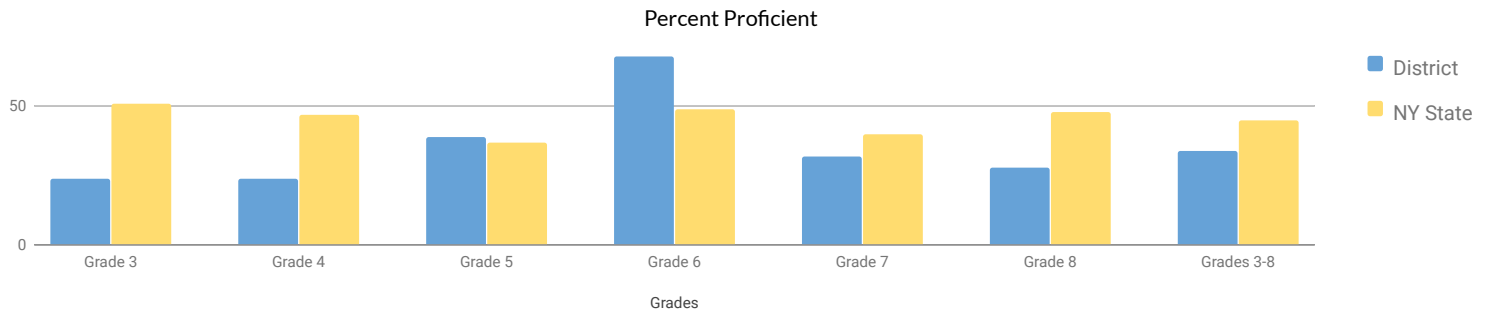


## BELFAST CSD - NEW YORK STATE REPORT CARD [2017 - 18]

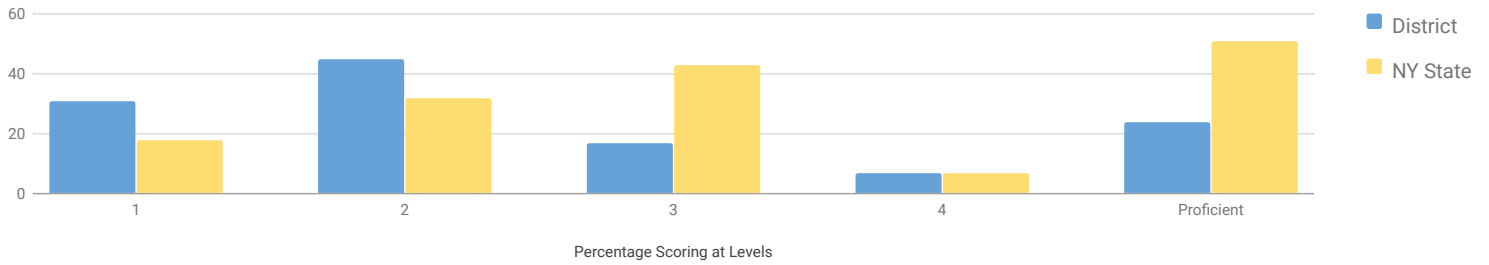
2017-18 Grades 3-8 ELA and Math results cannot be compared to those from previous years, as these tests were redesigned in 2017-18.

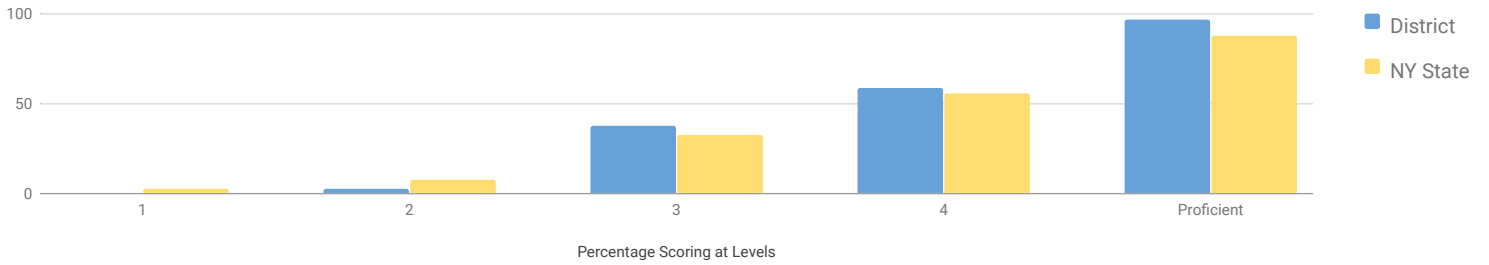

**ANNUAL REGENTS ENGLISH (2017-18)**



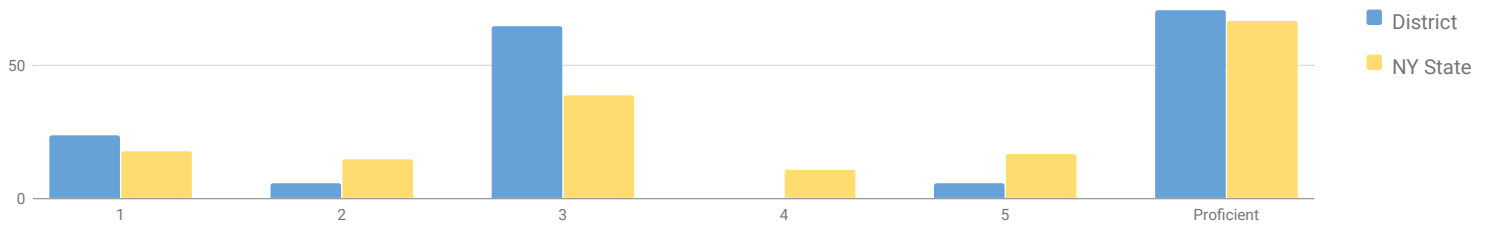

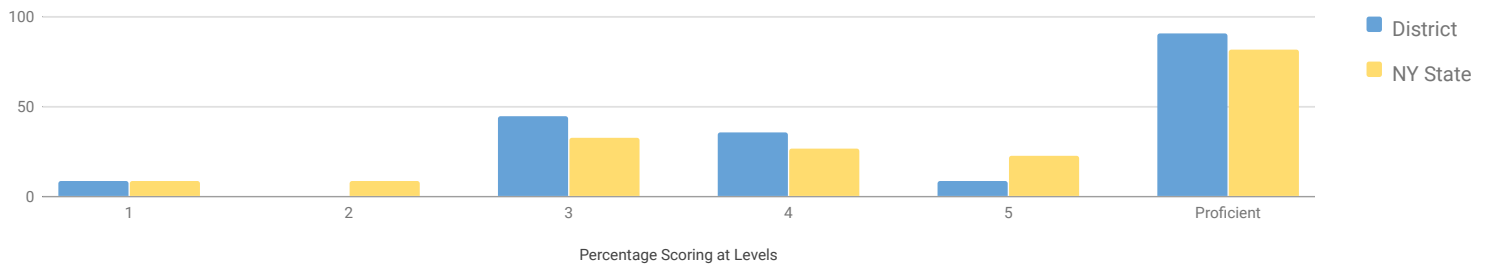
## ANNUAL REGENTS GEOMETRY (2017-18)

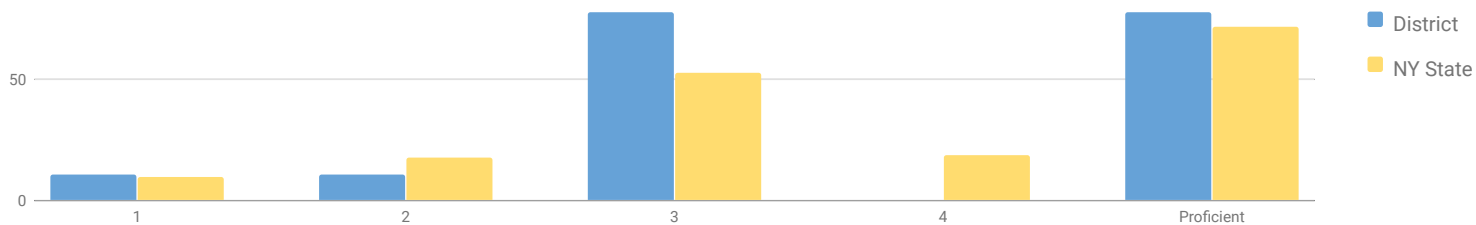
