Dear Parents/Guardians

The District participates in the National School Lunch Program and must meet a federal minimum average lunch price. Amity Regional School District is increasing lunch prices by 25 cents this school year. I am sure you have experienced higher grocery bills in the past four years. Though there has been a significant increase in the cost of food for the school meal program, the District was able to apply for supplemental State funding to support the program. Most of the supplemental funding has ended.

The State is continuing to subsidize the families on reduced meals for the 2024-2025 school year. Families who complete the free and reduced lunch [application](#) on our website and qualify for free or reduced meals, will receive free meals. The District encourages families to complete an application.

There has not been an increase in lunch prices since 2020. The middle school lunch price and each tier of lunch price at the high school will increase by 25 cents. The increase was approved by the Board of Education last evening and is effective immediately. Breakfast prices will remain unchanged.

Parents are reminded to deposit funds into their child's account on [MyPaymentsPlus](#) and maintain a positive balance during the year.
