Facility Needs

- Bus garage ladder cage
- Playground surface/ equipment
- Baseball field
- Outside basketball and tennis court resurface
- Tennis court fence
- Door replacement—started through the Smart Schools project
- Ceiling tile replacement in hallways and classrooms

- Rubber stair treads need to be replaced—done through regular budget
- Locker room restrooms and shower updates
- Classroom restroom updates
- Primary hall coat hangers

To maximize District resources, maintain the District facilities, and minimize fluctuations in the budget, Belfast Central School is working to create a long-term plan for capital and capital outlay projects. The initial proposed plans are based on current information on the status of components of the building and forecasted debt payments. The needs of the District will be reviewed annually to ensure information is as up to date as possible.

A proposition should be added to the 2022 school budget vote to create a capital reserve to fund the local share of future capital projects.
