Social Security Number (or A-number for non-citizens)



Driver's License or Permit (If you have one)

FSA ID and Password (Create at studentaid.gov - participant & parent/guardian need their own)

IRS Form 1040 & NYS IT-201 from 2 Years Prior (Example: 2020 tax returns for receiving financial aid in 2022-23 year)



Records of Untaxed Income (Child support, interest income, VA benefits, etc.)

Records of Your Assets

(Bank account balances, value of any investments, any real estate besides primary residence, etc.)


