



DELAYED START PROCEDURES

During a delayed start, school will begin at 10 a.m.

These guidelines are what our families can expect when the Calcasieu Parish School Board must implement a delayed start to the school day for students, faculty, and staff. This may be implemented for various reasons including but not limited to brief times of severe weather, extreme cold temperatures, and frozen precipitation.

WHEN WILL YOU KNOW?

We will inform families, students, and staff by 9 p.m. if a closure is necessary or if a closure decision will be made the following morning. If the decision is delayed to the morning hours, communication will take place at 5 a.m.

If your child rides a bus, please have them at their designated bus stop exactly two hours later than normal. A modified breakfast will be provided on these days. Routes between campuses for programs will be modified and determined on a case-by-case basis. Communication will occur with families as needed. Alternative sites will conduct virtual days instead of a delayed start.
