parenting with WISDOM

2024

As school ramps up for another year, we will spend some time each month focusing on developing skills in our students that can impact their decision making, academic performance, and prepare them for life outside of school. The first of these skills is wisdom.

Wisdom may not seem like the most obvious first choice to start the year— it might feel like wisdom requires time and experience to acquire, and here we are at the beginning of a school year— feeling all of the newness and excitement that it brings. But the skill of wisdom might just be the perfect start for a new year.

Developing wisdom in our kids often includes helping them make the right choices, but also in helping them know how to make the right decision in different situations and circumstances. Sometimes there is more than one "right" answer, and helping them determine what is "right" for that time and in that circumstance will be helpful to them in the long run as they endeavor to make decisions on their own in the future. For example, if they are invited to a sleepover tonight with some great friends, but last night they were up late and have a busy week ahead, holding a discussion about the best choice in that situation may help them to do what is wise. In other words, helping them determine what is best for them now will set them on the path to making wise choices later!

Questions to consider:

- Do you consider yourself wise? Why or why not?
- · How does your child find wisdom?
- In what ways do you allow your child to practice being wise?

Questions to ask your student:

- . Who do you know that is wise? Why do you think they are wise?
- · What does wisdom look like for a teenager?
- · How can our family support you in making wise choices?

Help Child Find Locate Children with Disabilities

What Is Child Find?

Child Find is a statewide effort by the Alabama State Department of Education and the Department of Rehabilitation Services to locate, identify, and evaluate children with disabilities from birth to age 21.

How Does Child Find Work?

Early Intervention and Special Education Services work closely with community service agencies, parents, and local school systems to locate children with disabilities. A toll-free number is provided for parents or other persons interested in information about referring a child from birth to age 21.

Why Is Child Find Important?

It helps the child, the family, and the provider to plan appropriate services and link families to services for students meeting eligibility requirements in the following disability areas:
