Considerations while using this Matrix

- 1. The consequences and offense should match.
- 2. OSS only when needed (see the 3 reasons in the footer).
- 3. In lieu of options should be considered when administering OSS.
- 4. Suspensions can be reduced from the Matrix suggestions with the use of an intervention, i.e. Civil Citations, CINS Referral, Mental Health Referrals, Paired to Mentor, etc. If doing reductions of suspension please keep to the normal reduction rates.
- 5. Any student having level 3 or level 4 infractions can be brought before the school's student services team. The expressed purpose of the team is to provide interventions and support (MTSS) to help students be successful on campus. In the event that students are not complying with the school's recommendations, they will be subject to the District's Multidisciplinary Team.
- 6. Each administrator/dean can use their discretion to ask for a safety assessment. In the event that you want a safety assessment, please have your guidance counselor complete the initial screening.
- 7. A manifestation will be required for any student who has reached 5 days of OSS or 3 incidents of OSS. Each new incident will require the IEP team to reconvene.

The matrix is our working document and it works best when we all consistently use it and provide feedback on its effectiveness. There are times when an administrator may need to give an alternative consequence that isn't listed. The discipline matrix sets forth the guidelines for assessing violations of Flagler County School Board and school campus policies. School administrators have the discretion to deviate from these guidelines by assessing an appropriate consequence other than the one stated in the Matrix if they determine that there are mitigating or aggravating circumstances.

*OSS is reserved for 3 reasons: Time and Space, Safety and Security, and Investigation. No student should be assigned excessive OSS without District Office notification. <u>When applicable, students should be allowed to utilize In Lieu of Suspension options.</u> Restorative practices and questions should be utilized when possible.

When reporting a SESIR incident, districts are required to report all related elements that are present or contribute to a reported incident. A related element must be reported even where it duplicates the incident. For example, when reporting an Alcohol incident, the Alcohol-related element must also be reported. For each SESIR incident, applicable "Related Elements" must also be reported to SESIR:

- Alcohol-Related
- Bullying-Related
- Drug-Related
- Gang-Related
- Hate Crime-Related

- Hazing-Related
- Injury-Related
- Vaping-Related
- Weapon-Related

Every Weapon Possession incident must be coded as <u>Weapon-Related</u> and must include the "<u>Weapon, Description</u> (PDF)" data element.
