AI PRESENTATION

The Educational Services Division presented an innovative Artificial Intelligence (AI) initiative aimed at enhancing learning experiences for students and supporting staff at WSD. During the 2023-2024 academic year, the newly formed i4 team spearheaded this effort, bringing together a diverse committee of 30 educators to explore AI's potential in education. The team's primary focus has been to:

- Investigate AI applications in the classroom
- Develop strategies for integrating AI tools
- Assess the impact on student learning outcomes

The Board of Trustees carefully reviewed the proposed timeline and discussed upcoming steps for implementing AI policies. This forward-thinking approach demonstrates WSD's commitment to leveraging cutting-edge technology to improve educational outcomes.
