

**ROSSVILLE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT
SCHOOL BOARD MEETING**

August 6, 2024

The School Board met on August 6, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the Rossville Consolidated School District's Media Center. Members present were Joe Hufford, Nathan Root, and Nathan McCullough.
