PSAT Test:

Any sophomore or junior who would like to take the Preliminary SAT (PSAT) test should sign up in the counselors' office by Friday, September 6. The test will be given in October (after Fall Break).

SCC Withdraw Deadline:

Monday, September 16 is the last day to withdraw from an SCC class and receive a 50% refund.

Sophomores (Gatton or Craft):

If you are a high-achieving sophomore who would like to apply for WKU's Gatton Academy or Morehead's Craft Academy, you must score a 22 in Math on the ACT test, and you must take (or have taken) Geometry and Algebra 2. The ACT test will be given in September, October, and December. You will need to take it. Register online at www.act.org. Please stop by the counselors' office or the GEAR-UP office for registration/fee waiver information.

Juniors (GSP):

If you are a junior interested in applying for the Governor's Scholars Program (GSP), you must have an ACT or PSAT score on file. The ACT will be offered in September, October, and December. You must register for one of those exam dates at www.act.org. Stop by the counselors' office to see if you qualify for an ACT fee waiver.

Registration Deadline for the October ACT:

If you would like to take the ACT test on Saturday, October 26, then you must register online by Friday, September 20. Stop by the counselors' office or the Gear-Up office to see if you qualify for a fee waiver. www.act.org
