It didn't have to be imagined Tuesday evening at Cavalier Stadium, where it was on full display as Crockett County High School's girls soccer team managed a 1-1 draw with visiting Augustine School.

"We didn't possess the ball very well, and neither did they," Lady Cavalier Coach Carli Branson said. "The ball was just kind of pinballing around the field the whole game. Neither team seemed to establish any kind of rhythm, and at least for us, that means we didn't communicate well with each other."

While that aspect of the game was disappointing for Crockett, the team once again played fairly solidly defensively, with its only lapse coming on an early first-half corner kick by the Lady Knights that somehow trickled through the sea of bodies in front of Lady Cav goaltender Amaria Walker and then eluded her grasp as it took a spinning bounce. It was the first goal allowed by Crockett's defense in three games – but it was the last one for the day.

Walker made seven saves after that, at least three of which came on dives onto the ball when Augustine players managed to create a breakaway situation or otherwise slid past Crockett's back line. Walker made another nifty kick save with her left foot on a hard shot to the right corner midway through the second half to keep Augustine's point total singular.

Meanwhile, Lady Cav Braniya Green evened up the score when she took a perfect assist pass from Rebecca Waddey and steered it just inside the back left post, putting just enough height on it to sail above the Lady Knight goalie.

"We didn't know anything about Augustine prior to the game," Branson said, "but they have several good athletes. We were fortunate to hold them to one goal, especially without communicating with each other like we need to. We have some young players, and maybe they don't feel confident enough yet to talk out loud and holler to each other, but that's something we definitely will be working on."

The Lady Cavs are now 2-0-1 and will host Huntingdon Thursday at 5:30, barring a forecasted heat index situation.
