Canfield High School has approximately 725 students in grades 9-12. We have consistently been ranked # 1 in Mahoning County, and annually been reported as a U.S. News and World Report Nationally Ranked High School.

A total of 24 credits is required for graduation, including: 4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 Social Studies, .5 Health, .5 Physical Education (or the waiver), and 1 Fine Art credit.

Students who attend the Mahoning County Career & Technical Center must additionally meet the CHS graduation requirements, with the exception Fine Art.
