Amir's consistent attendance and enthusiasm for learning are evident every day, particularly in his favorite subject, reading, where he is currently excelling on a third-grade level.



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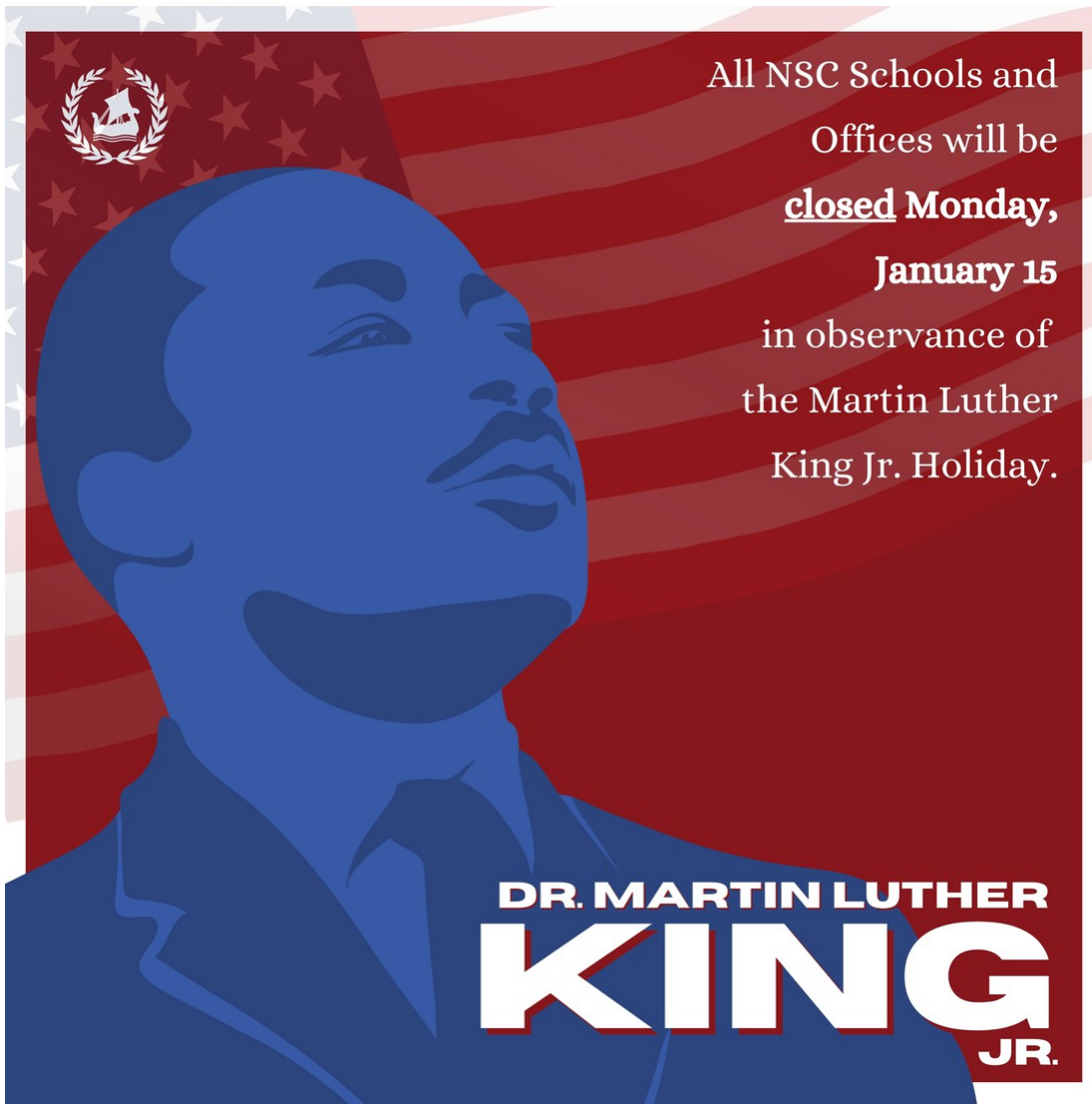
