

District Focused on School Safety

During the March board meeting, board members approved hiring five additional security personnel for our schools. These personnel will join our current safety and security department, which was recently restructured to improve coverage and increase supervision.

Since August 2023, the district has invested more than \$400,000 in safety and security initiatives, including purchasing badges for all staff that can be used as panic buttons during a crisis. We are also updating our surveillance systems to provide broader coverage and better monitoring of school premises, installing state-of-the-art metal detectors and scanners in many of our schools, and mandating clear book bags and Yonder pouches for our Middle and High School students.

District officials are working with our community leaders, including the 24:1 and local municipalities, to create a task force that addresses violence in our schools and communities.

Our actions underscore our unwavering commitment to prioritizing the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors.

Let's continue working together to foster a safe, nurturing environment where every student can thrive!
