NHS Students Shine on the National Chess Stage

What an incredible debut for Normandy High School at the National High School K-12 Chess Championship in Baltimore this April! Students Zechariah Barber and Amir Brown used their exceptional chess skills, earning well-deserved medals in their divisions and competing with more than 400 players from schools nationwide. Zechariah secured the 29th rank in the Under-800 category, while Amir tied for 35th place in the Under-1200 section.

This is just the beginning for Normandy on the national chess scene, and it wouldn't have been possible without the support of mentor Ms. Aparna Chandra, who leads the after-school chess program. In addition to securing over \$10,000 in grants for the program, she is a dedicated advisor, fostering a culture of excellence at Normandy.
