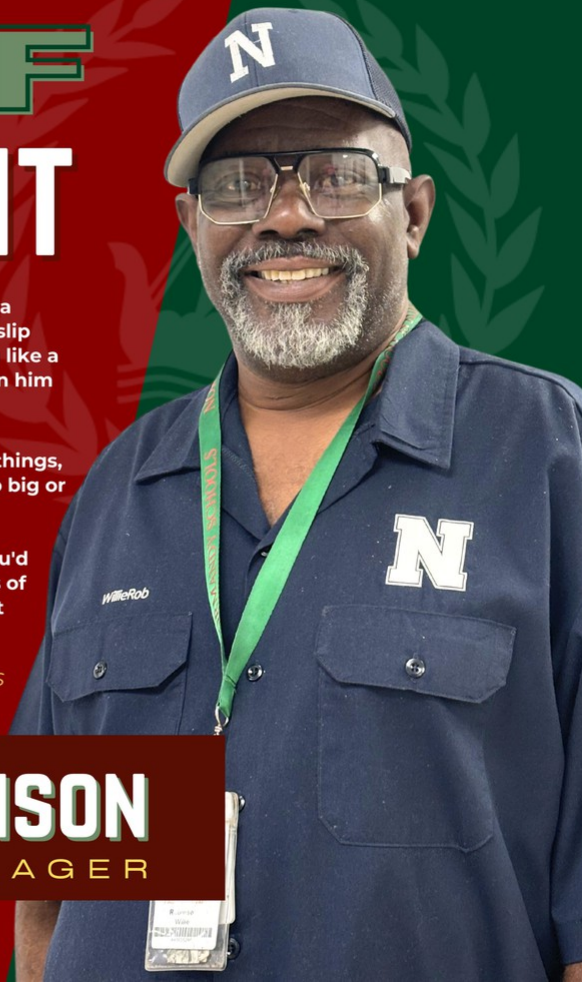
He's got a magic touch when it comes to fixing things, and he does it all with a smile. No problem is too big or too small for him to handle.
