General Business, Board Reports

- Board Members shared information regarding recent events/functions and other community related activities.

Superintendent's Report

- Back to School Update: Superintendent Hays reported on the following: Summer programs for students at MHS, SPED and ELOP; CNS summer meal program that provided over 40,000 meals; thanked all staff members for providing educational and wellness services to the students this summer; new cell phone policy; new electronic hall pass program for the secondary sites; dual language immersion program at Flory; middle school targeted after school support (ELOP) focusing on literacy and math skills; implementation of Alert Us program, confidential reporting platform, for students and families; staffing update; solar update; first day of school for THS@MC was August 5th; teacher inservice on August 15th; and active assailant training for all staff on August 19th.
- Public Information Officer Report: Daniel Wolowicz and David Roberts presented a report of activities and communications generated for the District, including upcoming projects.
