Excessive absences may result in loss of credit, truancy or both.

BUS STOP INFORMATION

BRIDGES STUDENTS RIDE BUS #64 TO BRIDGES FROM PLHS AND BACK AGAIN

BUS SCHEDULES, INCLUDING PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF TIMES AND LOCATIONS, WILL BE POSTED IN INFINITE CAMPUS NEAR THE END OF AUGUST.

PARENTS AND GUARDIANS ARE ABLE TO ACCESS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION BY LOGGING IN TO INFINITE CAMPUS.

PLEASE BE SURE TO LOOK

AT THIS INFORMATION AGAIN RIGHT BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS AS TIMES CAN CHANGE DUE TO ROUTING AND/OR STOP ADJUSTMENTS.

STUDENTS SHOULD BE AT THEIR BUS STOP 5 MINUTES PRIOR TO THEIR SCHEDULED PICK-UP TIME. ALTHOUGH AFTERNOON DROP-OFF TIMES WILL BE LISTED, THE P.M. SCHEDULES CAN CHANGE SLIGHTLY IN THE FIRST WEEKS OF SCHOOL AS WE ADJUST TO SCHOOL END-TIME ROUTINES AND ROAD CONSTRUCTION. YOU WILL NOTICE A MORE ACCURATE PATTERN OF AFTERNOON BUS DROP-OFF TIMES BEGINNING ABOUT THE SECOND WEEK OF SCHOOL.

Student Information Updates

Supply Lists

Bridges does not have a required supply list. Many students do use pens, pencils and notebooks! We also welcome donations of school supplies like tissues, hand sanitizer, wipes, pencils, paper, etc!

Driving and Parking at Bridges

Bridges requires all student drivers to fill out a permit form and have parent/ guardians complete a permission questionnaire.

Breakfasts are on campus only (Bridges/Twin Oaks)- students may not leave school property.

Students in 10th, 11th and 12th grade may leave campus for lunch with parental and administration's permission and good behavior.

This privilege will be removed if the student begins to encounter issues with attendance, grades or behavior.

Additionally, if this privilege is abused by behaving inappropriately during time away, being tardy upon return or returning under the influence, open lunch will be removed. In addition, further school and/or legal consequences may result.

Students may only leave campus at lunch if they are in 10th-12th grade and have all required permissions.


BRIDGES IS A CLOSED CAMPUS

Bridges is a CLOSED campus other than the lunch exceptions mentioned above. Please make sure your student brings everything into school with them. Due to safety expectations of our district, we do not permit students to go in and out of the building during the day without administrator permission. If you are dropping something off, please drop it off in the front office. Thank you!











Health Services

PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, WE ASK THAT YOU UPDATE YOUR STUDENT'S HEALTH HISTORY IN INFINITE CAMPUS SO WE ARE ABLE TO ACCURATELY ASSESS YOUR STUDENT IF THEY VISIT THE HEALTH OFFICE.

IF YOUR STUDENT REQUIRES MEDICATION (PRESCRIPTION AND/OR OVER-THE-COUNTER) DURING THE SCHOOL DAY, PLEASE COMPLETE THE MEDICATION FORM (SEE SCHOOL NURSE TO PICK UP) AND RETURN IT TO THE HEALTH OFFICE OR MAIN OFFICE AT BRIDGES.




