Glossary of District Tests / Assessments

- **ACCESS for ELLs:** Assessments administered to English language learners (ELL) in order to measure progress toward meeting Minnesota standards for English language development.
- **ALT ACCESS for ELLs:** Assessments administered to English language learners (ELL) in order to measure progress toward meeting Minnesota standards for English language development for Special Education students.
- **ACT:** The American College Test is a standardized test that measures a student’s skills in five core areas: English, math, reading, science, and writing. Students in grades 11 and 12 take the ACT so that they can submit their scores to colleges as part of the college application process.
- **ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery):** Multiple aptitude battery test that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military.
- **FAST:** Benchmark assessment to measure students’ current reading and math levels.
- **IB (International Baccalaureate Assessment):** The International Baccalaureate® (IB) assesses student work as direct evidence of achievement against the stated goals of the Diploma Programme (DP) courses.
- **MCA (Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments):** State tests that help districts measure student progress toward Minnesota academic standards and also meet federal and state legislative requirements.

- **MCIS** (Minnesota Career Information System): Comprehensive career exploration program with interest surveys, employment skills assessments, and learning styles. Middle school and high school.
- **MTAS** (Minnesota Test of Academic Skills): State alternate assessment (series of tasks) given to students with the most significant cognitive disabilities that measures performance on alternate achievement standards.
- **MySAEBRS** (My Social, Academic, and Emotional Risk Screener): Identifies students who are at-risk for academic, social, and/or emotional behaviors.
- **PSAT** (Preliminary SAT): Preparation for ACT or SAT and qualification exam for National Merit Scholarship Program

Glosario de exámenes / evaluaciones del distrito

- **ACCESS for ELLs**: evaluaciones administradas a los estudiantes que están aprendiendo inglés (ELL) con el fin de medir el progreso hacia el cumplimiento de los estándares de Minnesota para el desarrollo del idioma inglés.
- **ALT ACCESS para ELLs**: evaluaciones administradas a los estudiantes que están aprendiendo inglés (ELL) con el fin de medir el progreso hacia el cumplimiento de los estándares de Minnesota para el desarrollo del idioma inglés para los estudiantes de educación especial.
- **ACT**: El American College Test es un examen estandarizado que mide las habilidades de un estudiante en cinco áreas básicas: inglés, matemáticas, lectura, ciencias y escritura. Los estudiantes en los grados 11 y 12 toman el ACT para que puedan enviar sus puntajes a las universidades como parte del proceso de solicitud de la universidad.
- **ASVB** (Batería de aptitud vocacional de los servicios armados): Prueba de batería de aptitud múltiple que mide las habilidades desarrolladas y ayuda a predecir el éxito académico y ocupacional futuro en el ejército.
- **FAST**: Evaluación de referencia para medir los niveles actuales de lectura y matemáticas de los estudiantes.
- **MCA** (Evaluaciones integrales de Minnesota): exámenes estatales que ayudan a los distritos a medir el progreso de los estudiantes hacia los estándares académicos de Minnesota y también cumplen con los requisitos

legislativos federales y estatales.

- **MTAS** (Prueba de Destrezas Académicas de Minnesota): Evaluación alternativa estatal (serie de tareas) que se les da a los estudiantes con las discapacidades cognitivas más importantes que mide el desempeño en estándares de logros alternativos.
- **MySAEBRS** (My Social, Academic, and Emotional Risk Screener): Mi evaluación de riesgo social, académico y emocional): Identifica a los alumnos quienes están a riesgo en lo académico, lo social y/o por comportamientos emocionales.
- **PSAT** (Preliminary SAT): Preparación para el ACT o SAT y un examen calificador para el programa de Merit Scholarship Program (programa de beca por mérito).
