

CFISD Audio Video Production Practicum

Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

Students will work as contractors to produce videos for a wide variety of organizations. Under the supervision of their AVP teacher, the practicum student will identify community production opportunities off campus, conduct meetings with clients, and manage video production equipment and crews. Students will also have the opportunity to pursue the training and certification needed to film using a drone. This course requires students to arrange their own transportation to produce a wide variety of media projects.

- Grade 12 - *Audio Video Production 2* is a prerequisite.
- Students are required to have an approved training site/client within 15 school days after enrollment in the course.
- A \$30 supply fee is required for these courses.
