

5111 ADMISSIONS

Based on the board of education's equal educational opportunity resolution, the board guarantees admission provided the student meets the admission standard established in the schools. The chief school administrator or designee shall develop criteria for admissions based on academic achievement, district developed admissions assessments, and the recommendation of the principal/guidance counselor from the local district in the case of shared-time students. Auditions will be required for all Academy for Performing Arts applicants.

The educational goals will be reviewed with each candidate to ensure his/her understanding of the goals and willingness to develop a work ethic that will contribute to the achievement of these goals.

All employees in the schools will strive to assist students who are admitted to achieve competency and his/her ultimate goal of gainful employment or continuing education.
