Dear Friends,

Each year the Archdiocese of Miami invites missionary to our parishes through the Mission Cooperative Program, allowing to support global missions and promote the missionary call among the faithful here in the Archdiocese. This year we are honored and grateful to welcome The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) to visit our St. Agnes Catholic Parish and share their noble mission with our community.

The LSMIG are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in in Northern Uganda (East Africa). They serve those recovering from civil war and refugee crises. With limited resources, they are bravely responding to the needs of these people and especially to the refugee child-mothers and their children in the camps through a Catholic Education Center, offering vocational training and daycare to break the cycle of teenage pregnancy and give these girls and their children a brighter future.

St. Agnes Catholic Parish Rectory Project

New Parish Residence for Our Priests and Seminarians

Dear St Agnes Family,

As a Catholic parish, one of our fundamental responsibilities is to provide a safe and suitable residence for the priests who dedicate their lives to serving our community. The current rectory, which has been home to our priests for many years, is now in a state of disrepair that poses serious health and safety concerns. After years of postponement, we have reached a point where we can no longer delay this critical project.

Our parish has grown significantly over the years, and the need for a comfortable, safe and functional residence has become urgent. We must now, not only accommodate our current priests, but also prepare for the possibility of an additional priest in residence as well as hosting seminarians who are training in service to our community. Unfortunately, after extensive evaluations, it has become clear that simple renovations to the existing dwelling will not suffice. The structure no longer meets the necessary Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade and State of Florida building codes, making rebuilding a parish home for our clergy, the only viable option.

This decision was not made lightly. After thorough deliberation and in consultation with the parish council, finance committee, and the Archdiocese of Miami, we have committed to constructing a new residence for our parish. This new home, owned by the Archdiocese of Miami, will meet the essential needs of our clergy and ensure that our priests, now and in the future, have a place to live that is both safe and conducive to their ministry.

We are deeply grateful to the generous donors within our parish who have already committed to supporting this project financially. Their contributions reflect a shared recognition of the importance of this endeavor.

Construction will begin soon, and in the meantime, Fr. JC and Fr. Andrew have temporarily moved to a rented apartment near the church. We understand that this is a significant undertaking, but it is necessary for the continued growth and spiritual well-being of our parish.

LITTLE SISTERS OF MARY IMMACULATE OF GULU

Who We Are: The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu, in Northern Uganda (East Africa).

Our Charism & Mission: the Charism of LSMIG is to share God's love and kindness to All. Our mission is to witness to the love of Jesus Christ to the poor and most vulnerable members of the society. We the LSMIG live our mission through: Catholic education, health, pastoral and social services in hard-to-reach areas. Our mission stations are in Uganda, Kenya, Italy, Germany and the USA.





Our Current Ministry: The LSMIG Sisters are uniquely serving a people of northern Uganda who are emerging from a nearly 30 years of devastating civil war while concurrently dealing with influx of refugees from South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). According the United Nations High Commission for Refugees Report (UNHCR- September 2023) Uganda is a home to 1.56 million refugees and 57% of these are settled in northern Uganda. Among the refugees are children who arrived in

Uganda unaccompanied. The little girls in particular have suffered sexual violence which left them pregnant and they have become child-mothers at 13-15 year of age. The plight of these girls is most devastating in the post COVID period. The United Nation report of 2023 indicated that teenage pregnancy among refugee girls increased by 33%.

Our sisters are responding courageously with limited resources, to the need of these refugee child-mothers and children in the refugee camps through catholic education and catholic youth outreach programs. We have developed a unique Catholic Elementary Education Center with a blend of Vocational training, Daycare and Kindergarten to support education of the child mothers and their babies on the same campus. Our LSMIG Sisters have made this bold move to break the cycle of teenage pregnancy and child motherhood and to give these girls and their babies a second chance in school through an innovative Catholic Education.



We kindly invite you, through your Pastor, to consider financial support for the mission of the Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu in Uganda, to break the cycle of child motherhood in the refugee camps and to impart our Catholic values of God's love and kindness to these children through Catholic Education.


