## Student Chromebook Troubleshooting Guide

Before going to the library to ask for help with your Chromebook, see if you can solve the problem using this guide.

Chromebook Issue	Try this
I am having a non-specific issue with my Chromebook.	<ol> <li>Holding the power button down for 30 seconds and restarting the Chromebook will solve many of the Chromebook issues. <u>Closing the lid of your Chromebook does not power it off, it only logs you</u> <u>off and puts it to sleep. To power it off you have to tell it to shut down or</u> <u>hold the power button down</u>.</li> </ol>
My Chromebook will not turn on.	<ol> <li>Plug in the charger to make sure you have power.</li> <li>Check to make sure the red charging light is on.</li> <li>Hold down the power button for 20 seconds, then let go and click the power button again. <u>Fully dead devices need more than a couple of minutes to</u> <u>charge enough to turn on.</u></li> <li>Plug the charging cord into a different outlet.</li> <li>Try a different charger.</li> </ol>

My Chromebook will not connect to the wifi.	<ol> <li>Click on the time in the bottom right-hand of the screen - click on the wifi symbol. Next, click on the blue button on the right to turn off the wifi. Click the blue button again to turn the wifi back on.</li> <li>Restart your device by clicking the power button, then select the click on the power icon.</li> </ol>
My Chromebook is running slow or freezing up.	<ol> <li>Restart your device by clicking the power button, then select the click on the power icon - if the power icon does not show up, hold the power button until it shuts down (up to 15 seconds).</li> <li>Uninstall some of the apps or extensions installed on Chrome.</li> </ol>
I cannot log on to the Chromebook.	<ol> <li>Check to ensure that the Chromebook is connected to the internet.</li> <li>Make sure you are using the correct username and password for your account.</li> </ol>
My keys are not typing the right letters.	<ol> <li>Click on the clock in the bottom right-hand corner.</li> <li>Click on "Keyboard" and make sure it is set to "US."</li> <li>If it isn't, change it and this will fix the problem.</li> <li>If it is, try powering off and back on your computer.</li> </ol>

One of my keys fell off my keyboard.	1. Put the key pieces in a safe place so you don't lose them.
It is asking me for my old password.	<ol> <li>Click "Forgot Password."</li> <li>On the next page, you will be presented with two options. Click the button that says "Proceed Anyway."</li> <li>You should now be able to log into your Chromebook with your current password.</li> </ol>
My touchpad won't let me click and I need to click and drag for class.	<ol> <li>Click on the clock in the lower right-hand corner.</li> <li>Click on the gear icon to open settings.</li> <li>Select "Device" on the left-hand side.</li> <li>Select "Mouse and Touchpad."</li> <li>Under Touchpad toggle on "Enable Tap Dragging."</li> <li>Close settings.</li> <li>Double tap and hold on to the item you want to drag.</li> <li>Drag the item where you need it to go.</li> </ol>
I feel like picking at my Chromebook screen and popping the frame casing on and off.	<ol> <li>Don't.</li> <li>Find a fidget or something else to pick at. Popping the frame case on and off may cause you to break your screen and without the protection plan, the replacement cost is \$50.</li> </ol>

The casing around the screen of my Chromebook popped open.	<ol> <li>Do not attempt to pop it back on yourself.</li> <li>Take it to your teacher to have them attempt to pop it back in or bring it to the library for this. Doing it yourself may break the screen.</li> </ol>
