The supplies below are individualized by the teacher and are in addition to the generic Kindergarten list that you received from all of the teachers.

{If purchasing school supplies places a hardship on your family, supplies will be provided.} All supplies will be shared by all so there is no need to label each item.

Please also supply the items below-

- 1 package of Post-its any color any size**
- 1 tray of Crayola watercolor paints -6 colors**
- 3 bottles of pump soap**
- 2 large containers of playdoh**
- wipes and tissues would be so appreciated**

Smock - Your child will need a smock for art labeled with their name. A men's dress shirt with the arms cut at wrist-length or an oversized t-shirt both work well.

Backpack -(bring on the first day of school) Your child's backpack should be large enough to fit a folder. Backpacks with wheels are not permitted.

Lunch and Snack- Please label lunch boxes or bags with your child's name. If your child is bringing lunch from home please label the lunch and snack separately so that your child knows what to eat at snack and lunch time. Please send in 1 box and 1 brown paper bag if they are bringing a lunch and snack so that it is easy to carry and fit in your child's backpack. **Your child needs a snack everyday starting the first day of school!!**

Extra Clothing -Please send in an extra set of clothing for your child: including one shirt, one pair of shorts AND pants, one pair of socks and one pair of underpants. **Label all clothing** with your child's name. Please put all extra clothing in a large Ziploc bag.

- We look forward to seeing you at Meet and Greet on Tuesday September 3, 2024 at 2:30 P.M. Please bring the supplies at this time in a bag labeled with your child's name.**

The following are suggested supplies you may wish to bring with you to school in September:

- 1 standard-sized elementary **backpack** (no wheels please)
- 1 hard **plastic pencil box** to store supplies in school (suggested size, 8" x 5", no larger than 9" x 6")
- 1 adult-sized t-shirt to use as a **smock** for art
- 1 **change of clothes** (including underwear & socks) in a labeled Ziploc bag ~ please label each clothing item
- 1 box of **thick and** 1 box of **thin** Crayola washable **markers** (not scented please, 10 count)
- 1 box of long Crayola **colored pencils**, sharpened **and** 1 box of Crayola **crayons** (24 count)
- 1 multi-pack each of small and large **glue sticks and** 1 bottle of **Elmer's school glue**
- 1 5" safety **scissor**, blunt (*Fiskars* brand, if possible)
- 1 box of pre-sharpened #2 **pencils** with erasers (12 count, *Ticonderoga* if possible)
- 6-12 low-odor, **thin, black dry erase markers** (*Expo* brand)
- 8 black **felt-tipped pens** (*PaperMate Flair*, if possible)
- 2 **plastic** (not plastic coated) **folders** with inside bottom pockets
- 2 **plastic pocket folders with 3-hole fasteners** inside, **one blue and one red** ●
- 1 **Primary Journal Creative Story Tablet** (Mead brand, K - 2, picture space on top/primary lines below)
- 1 on/over the ear adjustable band **headphones** (no earbuds, please; remove from packaging and label and place in a labeled Ziploc bag)
- 1 box of **tissues and** 1 package of **baby wipes**



In addition, a **donation** of any of the following items would be greatly appreciated: a box of snack size, sandwich or quart size, or 1 or 2 gallon **Ziploc baggies**; a roll of **paper towels**; a box of **plastic spoons or forks**; a box of **clear sheet protectors**; white **paper plates**, any size, non-coated, please (*Chinet* brand, if possible)
