In addition to the kindergarten supply list (see attached), I would like to request the following supplies for our classroom:

- I roll of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- I box of gallon size Ziploc bags and I box of quart size Ziploc bags
- 2 packages of baby wipes
- an additional pack of large glue sticks
- -1 watercolor paint set (Crayola, 16 colors)
- -1 large bottle of pump hand sanitizer



(If purchasing these items places a financial burden on you, please don't worry about them).

Snack - Please send in a healthy snack and water bottle everyday. Label the snack <u>separate</u> from your child's lunch (if you are also sending in a lunch from home). We are a nut free classroom.

<u>Backpack</u> must be without wheels and large enough to fit a folder and snack. Please label your child's backpack and lunchbox with his/her name and class.

<u>Extra Clothing</u> – Please send in <u>two sets</u> of extra clothes (shirt, pants, socks, and underwear) labeled with your child's name inside a <u>large</u> <u>shoebox</u>. One appropriate for warm weather and one set appropriate for the colder weather.

PARKVILLE KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

The following are suggested supplies you may wish to bring with you to school in September: {If purchasing school supplies places a hardship on your family, supplies will be provided.}

- 1 standard-sized elementary backpack (no wheels please)
- 1 hard **plastic pencil box** to store supplies in school (suggested size, 8" x 5", no larger than 9" x 6")
- 1 adult-sized **t-shirt** to use as a **smock** for art
- 2 **changes of clothes** (including underwear & socks) in a labeled Ziploc bag ~ please label each clothing item
- 1 box of thick <u>and</u> 1 box of thin Crayola washable markers (not scented please, 10 count)
- 1 box of long Crayola colored pencils, sharpened <u>and</u> 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 multi-pack each of small and large glue sticks <u>and</u> 1 bottle of Elmer's school glue 1 5" safety scissor, blunt (Fiskars brand, if possible)
- 1 box of pre-sharpened #2 **pencils** with erasers (12 count, *Ticonderoga* if possible) 1 double pack of large pink **erasers**
- 6-12 low-odor, thin black dry erase markers (Expo brand, if possible)
- 8 black **felt-tipped pens** (*Paper Mate Flair*, if possible)
- 2 plastic (not plastic coated) folders with inside bottom pockets
- 2 plastic pocket folders with 3-hole fasteners inside, one blue and one red 1 Primary Journal Creative Story Tablet/Notebook (Mead brand,

K-2, picture space on top/primary lines below, if possible)

- 1 **on/over the ear** adjustable band **headphones** (no earbuds, please; remove from packaging and label and place in a labeled Ziploc bag)
- 1 box of tissues and 1 package of baby wipes

In addition, a <u>donation</u> of any of the following items would be greatly appreciated: a box of snack size, sandwich or quart size, or 1 or 2 gallon *Ziploc baggies*; a roll of paper towels; a box of plastic spoons or forks; a box of clear sheet protectors; white paper plates, any size, non-coated, please (*Chinet* brand, if possible)
