Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

In a “hands-on” laboratory setting, students work with three and four-year-old students in a preschool educational environment, applying knowledge and skills related to child growth and guidance. (2 credits)

- ◆ **Grades 11 – 12**
- ◆ Recommended Prerequisite: Principles of Education and Training and/or Child Development
- ◆ Application and interview may be used if demand exceeds space available.
- ◆ Satisfies advanced course requirement for Public Services endorsement.
- ◆ Seniors receive CFISD Letter of Intent to Interview upon successful completion of program as well as the ability to earn an Educational Aide Certification.
- ◆ An application may be required if demand exceeds number of available slots.
- ◆ Lab supplies/uniform and class fees are required.
