Request for Proposal

The Flushing Community Schools Board of Education is accepting sealed proposals for **Raider Virtual Academy - Storage Building Roof Project** in accordance with the specifications, terms and conditions stated herein.

Proposals must be sealed and include the wording "SEALED BID – RAIDER VIRTUAL ACADEMY - STORAGE BUILDING ROOF PROJECT", on the outside.

Proposals will be accepted until **Thursday**, **June 6**, **2019 at 3:30 p.m. local time**. The Board will not accept a proposal received after the date and time mentioned above.

The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals, in whole or in part, and to waive any informality therein.

The project scope of work includes remove and replace existing roof of storage building. Alternate bids being accepted for re-sheeting of roof and replacement of overhangs and facia.

Bidder shall be licensed, bonded, and insured in the State of Michigan, be reputable, and be a recognized organization with successful experience on work of this type and scope.

All bids submitted shall include all material, labor and subcontractor costs for scope identified in the contract documents.

Section 4 - General Conditions

Permits, fees, and regulations

Bidder shall be responsible for obtaining all permits, licenses, and inspections necessary for the proper completion of the project.

<u>Taxes</u>

Flushing Community Schools is not automatically exempt from State of Michigan Sales and Use Taxes. The District must pay these taxes when materials are to be incorporated into realty. Materials that are permanently attached i.e., lockers, built-in, incorporated or otherwise made part of the structure all applicable taxes shall be paid by the Bidder. Flushing Community Schools shall not be responsible for any taxes that are imposed on the Bidder. Furthermore, the Bidder understands that it cannot claim exemption from taxes by virtue of any exemption that is provided to Flushing Community Schools.

<u>Safety</u>

Under the "General Conditions of the Contract", the Bidder shall take reasonable precautions for safety of all persons who may be affected including employees of the contractor and subcontractor.

Insurance Requirements

The Bidder shall indemnify the owner in the event of certain claims arising out of the performance of the work.

The Bidder shall maintain, at its expense, during the term of this contract the following insurance:

- a) Worker Compensation Insurance in accordance with statutory limits.
- b) Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with a minimum combined single limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$1,000,000 aggregate, in the same amount for bodily injury and property damage.

Warranty

All material and equipment will be guaranteed to be free from defects in both workmanship and materials for no less than two years from date of receipt/installation. If manufacturer warranty exceeds this minimum requirement, the manufacturer warranty will prevail. Any item(s) found to be defective will be replaced or repaired within seven working days at Bidder expense.

Compliance with School Safety Legislation

Meeting the requirements of the School Safety Initiative Legislation, the Bidder acknowledges and agrees that the bidder and all personnel (including subcontractors) are subject to iChat background checks.

The bidder is required to provide a written list of all personnel working on the project to the Deputy Superintendent including name, race, and date of birth.
