Michigan Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance: CTE Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$44,594,721ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$39,653,074
- Percent change: -11.08%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- ➤ In 2009-2010, almost all (94%) CTE students in Michigan graduated from high school on time, compared to the statewide rate of 75.95%ⁱⁱ
- ➤ The majority of secondary (94%) CTE students in Michigan were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010ⁱⁱⁱ
- ➤ Almost all (94%) of secondary CTE students in Michigan graduated high school on time^{iv}

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 123,106^v
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 220,829vi

CTE: Preparing Michigan's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in MI:

- → Marketing, Sales, and Services will be the largest Career Cluster overall.
- → Health Science will be the fastest growing, increasing by 17% by 2018.
- → In 2018, 40% of all jobs in MI will be found in Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism.
- → In MI by 2018, there will be about 451,000 jobs for those with certificates.
