## Michigan Career Technical Education (CTE)

### Statistics At-A-Glance:

#### CTE Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$44,594,721<sup>i</sup>
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$39,653,074
- Percent change: -11.08%

#### CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- In 2009-2010, almost all (94%) CTE students in Michigan graduated from high school on time, compared to the statewide rate of 75.95%<sup>ii</sup>
- The majority of secondary (94%) CTE students in Michigan were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010<sup>iii</sup>
- Almost all (94%) of secondary CTE students in Michigan graduated high school on time<sup>iv</sup>

#### CTE Enrollment Data:

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 123,106<sup>v</sup>
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 220,829<sup>vi</sup>

### CTE: Preparing Michigan's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

*From today through 2018 in MI:*

➔ *Marketing, Sales, and Services will be the largest Career Cluster overall.*

➔ *Health Science will be the fastest growing, increasing by 17% by 2018.*

➔ *In 2018, 40% of all jobs in MI will be found in Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism.*

➔ *In MI by 2018, there will be about 451,000 jobs for those with certificates.*
