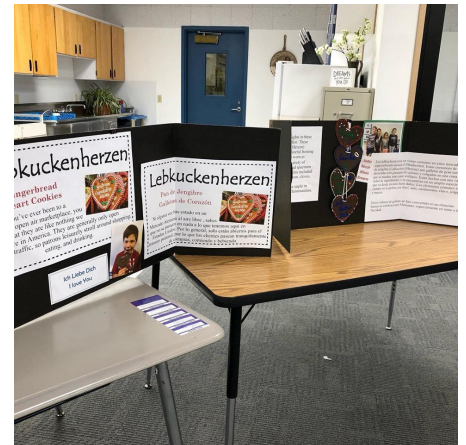
Celebration of Cultures of the World!
