Athletic Guidelines for Food Trucks

MISD Athletics has established the following guidelines for a food truck to operate on district property during any school athletic event or activity:

1. All food trucks must have a valid city permit to serve food to the public.
2. Owner of the food truck must receive written permission (email is acceptable) from the Head Coach of the sporting event they are attending.
3. Food truck vendors must receive written permission (email is acceptable) from the Booster Club/Organization that is providing concessions at the event. Approval must include the reimbursement amount/percentage of sales the vendor will provide to the Booster Club/Organization and the terms of payment.
4. Food truck vendors must secure permission from the Athletic Director's office. This approval is secured after the vendor submits the electronic MISD "Food Vendor Request Form" and its requested supporting documents.

Prior to the athletic event:

- Food Truck vendors must complete and submit the electronic MISD "Food Truck Vendor Request Form."
- All parties must agree in writing to the operation of the food truck vendor during the specified district athletic event.
- The submitted "Food Truck Vendor Request Form" must include all required attachments, including documentation verifying approval from the Head Coach of the sporting event and the Booster Club/Organization providing concessions at the event, to be considered completed.
- The Athletic Department will review Food Truck vendor request forms and will notify the requestor of final approval.
- Food Truck vendors will bring the final approval notice with them to the event. Upon arriving at the event, the Food Truck vendor will check in with the Booster Club/Organization prior to setting up.
