### A. Approval of Tax Levy Warrant

board, duly signed, shall be affixed to the above described tax rolls authorizing the collection of said taxes to begin September 1, 2022, and end October 31, 2022 giving the tax warrant an effective period of 61 days at the expiration of which time the tax collector shall make an accounting in writing to the board; AND IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED, that the delinquent tax penalties shall be fixed as follows: 1st month free, 2nd month interest of 2% added, 3rd month or fraction thereof, interest of 2% added.

Nolan, that the Board of Education, pursuant to Section 2509 of the Education Law upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and in compliance with Part 30.3 of the Rules of the Board of Regents, does hereby appoint *Ann-Marie Heiner* to the position of Secondary Mathematics Teacher in the tenure area of Secondary Mathematics for a probationary period of four years, to commence on September 1, 2022, and to expire on June 30, 2026 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provision of Section 3012³ of the Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary for this position is \$60,000 for the 2022-2023 school year.

Nolan, that the Board of Education, pursuant to Section 2509 of the Education Law upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and in compliance with Part 30.3 of the Rules of the Board of Regents, does hereby appoint *Holly Melnikow* to the position of Secondary Mathematics Teacher in the tenure area of Secondary Mathematics for a probationary period of four years, to commence on September 1, 2022, and to expire on June 30, 2026 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provision of Section 3012³ of the Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary for this position is \$50,000 for the 2022-2023 school year.
