NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a special meeting of the qualified voters of the Brookfield Central School District for the purpose of a school budget revote will be held in the OT/PT room of the Brookfield School Main Building, 1910 Fairground Road, Brookfield, NY 13314 on Tuesday, June 18, 2024 between the hours of 12:00 p.m./Noon and 8:00 P.M. prevailing time at which time the polls will be opened to vote by paper ballot upon the following items.

 To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2024-2025, and to authorize requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for 2024-2025, exclusive of public monies, may be obtained by any resident of the District during business hours beginning June 4, 2024 at the Brookfield Central School District Office. In addition, a copy of the tax exemption report, showing how much of the total assessed value of the final assessment role used in the budgetary process is exempt from taxation may also be obtained at the District Office.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications for absentee and early mail ballots will be obtainable between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM Monday through Friday, except holidays, from the District Clerk. Absentee and early mail ballot applications may be requested by letter received by the clerk not earlier than June 4, 2024

and no later than June 11, 2024. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee and early mail ballots must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00 PM

prevailing time, on Tuesday, June 18, 2024.

A list of persons to whom absentee and early mail ballots are issued will be available for public inspection and legal challenge until the day of election to qualified voters of the District in the office of the District Clerk on and after June 4, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM on weekdays prior to the date set for the annual election.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law §2018-c. Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the school district may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.
