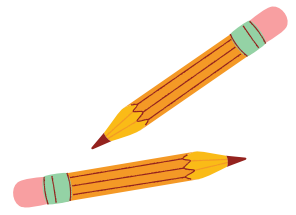




FLUSHING COMMUNITY SCHOOLS ANNOUNCES: Kindergarten & Developmental Kindergarten Registration for the 2024/2025 school year!



Children born on or before September 1, 2019 are age ready for kindergarten for the 24/25 school year. If your child turns five between September 2, 2024 and December 1, 2024 and you feel they may be ready for school, they may still be eligible for kindergarten or developmental kindergarten. Please follow the steps listed and eligibility will be discussed at your child's Kindergarten Round-Up appointment.

Flushing Community Schools is a "School of Choice" district. Families living outside of district boundaries are still able to participate in our Round-Up process however, they will still need to apply and be accepted through the SOC process before their student will be considered "fully registered". Out of district families will have the opportunity to apply for School of Choice in June. Information regarding that process will be posted to our district website, www.flushingschools.org, when it becomes available.

Scan the QR Code to begin the registration process. Please try and submit your registration no later than April 12th so that we can get your student scheduled for their Kindergarten Round-Up appointment.

After your registration has been submitted and processed, you will be contacted by the ECC via email asking you to schedule your student's Kindergarten Round-Up appointment.

Appointments will take place on:

April 23rd, 2024

**For families that register after our Round-Up day: Your child is still permitted to join us for the 24-25 school year. Staff may reach out to you at a later date to schedule a make-up round-up appointment.

If you did not upload required registration documents, please gather all of the paperwork for your incoming student and plan to bring it to their scheduled Round-Up appointment.

Required documents are:

- Birth Certificate
- Parent/Guardian Driver's License (Displaying the correct address.)
- One current proof of residency (In addition to the driver's license. This can include utility bill, tax bill, purchase/renter's agreement, etc.)
- Up-to-date Immunization Record
- Current Health Appraisal (Completed by a health care provider on or after 9/1/23)
- Hearing & Vision Screening (If your health care provider does not complete these screenings, we will provide information to you on free screenings completed by the GCHD)
- Oral Health Assessment (If your child does not have a dentist, we will provide information to you on free assessments)
- Custody Documentation (If Applicable)

On April 23rd, you and your student will come to the ECC for their Round-Up appointment. Utilize the Main Entrance located at the front of the building on Chamberlain St. Please come right at your scheduled appointment time and plan to bring any registration documents listed above unless they were previously submitted.

What to expect at the Kindergarten Round-Up Appointment: During these individual appointments, a kindergarten teacher will complete a readiness assessment with your child. This assessment will provide valuable information as we plan for your child's educational needs for the fall. After your child completes the 15-minute assessment, the teacher will review the information with you and possibly make suggestions for activities that you may want to do with your child. Teacher recommendation of Developmental Kindergarten for your child may also be discussed. Optional, fun activities will be available for you and your student to participate in once you complete your scheduled appointment.

Once Round-Up and paperwork are complete, your next step is to work with your child on suggested materials. The ECC office will be closed during the summer. Once we return Mid-August, we will mail out teacher welcome letters as we prepare to welcome our newest Jr. Raiders to the ECC!
