

SAUSALITO MARIN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Sausalito School District shall comprise all the area within the boundaries described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point three miles seaward of the most northwesterly corner of Ranch "I" and the most southerly corner of Ranch "J" as shown on the Tamalpais Land and Water Company Map No. 3, recorded in Map Book 1 on page 104, Marin County Records; thence shoreward three miles to the aforesaid northwesterly corner of Ranch "I"; thence northeasterly and easterly along the northwesterly and northerly lines of Ranches "I", "H", "G", and "F" to a point on the northerly line of Ranch "F", said point being the intersection of the courses $N60^{\circ}13'W$. 865.0 feet and $S51^{\circ}39'W$. 725.0 feet; thence crossing Ranch "F" on bearing $S60^{\circ}13'E$. 1,900 feet, more or less, to the point of intersection with the boundary line between Ranch "F" and Ranch "B", said point being $N20^{\circ}29'E$. 139.84 feet from the intersection of the courses $N48^{\circ}19'E$. 549.90 feet and $N20^{\circ}29'E$. 344.84 feet; thence in a northerly direction along the easterly boundary lines of Ranches "F" and "E" to the point of intersection of said line with the center line of the Coyote Canal and running thence northeasterly along the center line of said Coyote Canal to the point of intersection of said center line with the center line of the Saucelito Canal; thence southeasterly along the center line of said Saucelito Canal and its southeasterly prolongation to the southeasterly boundary of Marin County; thence southwesterly and westerly along the boundary line of Marin County to Point Bonita and continuing seaward along said Marin County boundary line three miles; thence northwesterly along a line parallel to the shoreline to the point of beginning.
